MEMBER SCHOLARSHIP BY-LAWS

1. Scholarship applicants must have been an active* member of Beulah Baptist Institutional Church (BBIC) for a minimum of one (1) year prior to their date of high school graduation.
2. Applicants must have received written notification, official letterhead, of acceptance into an accredited college or university.
3. Members desiring consideration for a scholarship must complete and submit an application, provided by BBIC, along with the official letter of acceptance received from the college or university which they plan to attend.
4. Active members electing to attend a beauty, barber or vocational school, military in lieu of a college or university, will be awarded a gift.
5. The application and required documentation process is the same for all members.
6. Members or non-active members entering the military or members who elect not to further their education beyond high school will be given a graduation gift.
7. BBIC members who are continuing their education will receive an annual book stipend pending verification.
8. The required verification for such stipend is receipt of an official transcript showing that the minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale has been achieved.

• Upon approval for a scholarship, active members will receive the award in ~~the~~ installment. The initial installment will be awarded at the beginning of the coming academic year (August).

10. Prior to the disbursement of the second installment, an official college transcript must be submitted to the Scholarship Committee that verifies that the required minimum (GPA) of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale has been achieved.

11. Scholarship awards will be made after a majority vote by committee members and recommendations by Rev. Brooks and approval by the Pastor.

***Definition: Active Member**

An active member is one who has joined with Beulah Baptist Institutional Church and been in regular attendance for a minimum of one (1) year prior to their date of graduation. Regular attendance shall include:
